- **We are in week 1 of our *Folktales & Fairy tales* theme.**
- **The academic word BRIEF is the focus of this week.** Try these examples to work even more exposures to the word **BRIEF** into your child's days -- or make up your own!
 - "Do you think you could watch just a **BRIEF** part of a favorite television show and be happy, or would it be better not to watch the show at all?"
 - "Sometimes when a person begins to tell you something, he says – 'I'll be BRIEF.' Why do you think people *tell you* first that they are going to be BRIEF, rather than just not saying much?"
 - Remind your child that **BRIEF** means lasting a short period of time or using just a few words.
- **Here are a few of our favorite questions from various age groups this week.**
 - *Before drinking the magic potion, the prince put on suntan _____.* Can we think of a word that rhymes with *potion* to end this silly sentence?
 - Would you rather hear a story that had elves as the magical characters in it, or a story that had witches in it? Why?
 - Are there any characters you've heard about in a book, or seen in a movie, that you felt sorry for?
