

Certified Staff

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Educational Goals During Closure

Goals Based on Guidance from DESE:

Kindergarten Sections

- · Budgeted for 17 classrooms
- Planned for 3 in Boxborough and 14 in Acton
- Recommending 4 in Boxborough and 13 in Acton
 - Class sizes 18 -18.5
 - Move from 3 K's to 4 at Blanchard
 - Move from 2 K's to 3 at Conant
- Provides more space at Conant for future years

Lottery and All Day K

- Small Lotteries at Merriam and Conant (4-5 each)
- Larger Lottery at Blanchard 11 Students
- 242 families selected All Day K (84%)
- 46 families selected Half Day K
- Will run one Half Day K at Blanchard Hybrids at the other schools
- All families in the lottery will receive their choice of ADK or Half Day K
